

Damp Mop cleaning procedures

Dining area, bathroom and kitchen floors

Products Needed



Multi-purpose degreaser
(for greasy kitchen floors)



Floor &
multi-surface
cleaner

Tools Needed



Broom &
dust pan



Mop Bucket
& Mop



Wet floor
sign

Frequency

According to the master
cleaning schedule.

Special Directions

Change out the floor cleaning solution when
it becomes dirty and after every use.

Damp Mop



Sweep floor.



Put out the wet
floor sign.



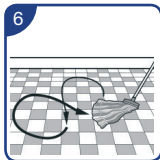
Fill mop bucket with
60ml/2 caps of product
(5 litre bucket) or
120ml/4 caps of product
(10 litre bucket).
Add warm water.



Place mop head
in solution and
move mop up and
down until the
mop is soaking
wet.



Place the mop head
in the mop wringer
and wring out as
much solution as
possible.



Mop a 3 metre
by 3 metre area
using a
figure-8 motion and
turning over mop at
least twice.

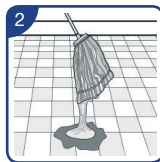


Move to the next 3 metre
by 3 metre area and repeat
Steps 5 to 7 until this task
is finished.

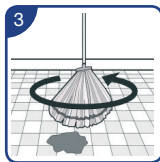
Hardened Soil Removal



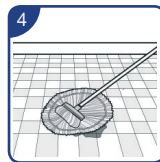
Place the mop head
in the solution and
move up and down
until the mop is
soaking wet.



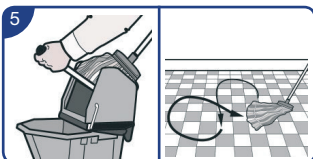
Wet the hardened
floor soil deposit
and allow to soak
5 minutes.



Twirl mop head to open
skirt to exposes the
interior scouring pad
and then drop the mop.



Scrub the area
with the interior
scouring pad to
loosen the soil.



Damp mop the area to remove
the loosened soil and cleaner
residues using Steps 5 to 7 in the
Damp Mop section of this procedure.
